Hey, I'm New Here! - Addressing people in the SCA

Two of the questions I am asked most by newcomers are "Why was that person called (insert title)?" and "How do I address people?" The easiest way to address someone if you aren't sure of his or her correct title is 'My Lord' or 'My Lady'. It is the most common and simplest title and works for everyone, including Kings and Queens. The next form of address, and possibly the most important, are the King and Queen. They are called 'Their Majesties/Your Majesty'. They are followed by the Prince and Princess or 'Their Highnesses/Your Highness'. Dukes and Duchesses are 'Your Grace' and if you overhear someone being called 'Your Excellency', they are either a Count/Countess or Baron/Baroness. 'Sir' is used for the Order of Chivalry and 'Master/Mistress' for members of the Order of the Laurel, the Order of the Pelican, and the Order of Defense. Don't worry, we'll cover how to recognize all of them next month. Just remember: when in doubt, My Lord/Lady is the best solution.
